

















Year 1 Homework Autumn 1

Can you do the same for your number bonds to 20?</p> 
<p>Science</p>	<p>Go on a walk around the park with an adult. What do you notice about the leaves and the trees? What colour are they? Can you sketch what you see?</p>	<p>Identify and name a variety of everyday materials you can find in your home</p> <p>E.G. Fork – Metal Table- wood</p>	<p>Carry out an experiment at home to find out which materials are waterproof. Design your own umbrella. Which material would you use to make it?</p>
